How much does it cost to put a student through One Degree?

It costs between £500 (direct student costs for a shorter programme) to £1100 (for a longer more rounded programme, including our minimal overheads) per student. How much of my donation goes direct to the programme?

Because we have minimal overheads (no office, one full-time staff member, we do not run marketing or fundraising events -without event sponsorship), your donation will go directly into the running of our programmes and towards our students.

Can I meet the student I put through One Degree?

This is absolutely possible. We do have a small student drop-out rate on our programmes which is inevitable, however most of our students do see the programmes through. You can either come and visit us on one of our programme days, we can send you student updates or you can even become a personal, academic or career mentor to a student (in addition to your donation).

How do I make my donation?
